A Public Hearing is scheduled seeking public input on the City of Monticello's FY 2023-2024 Budget and Tax Digest as proposed.

The following recommendations were made to be cut from the fiscal year 2024 budget reduce the Downtown Development payments by \$1,000, reduce Get Ahead House monthly payments by \$12,000, and reduce Parks site improvements by \$50,000, which the new Use of Fund Balance would be \$537,436.
